Abraham Lakin 2nd *Head of Family of Revolutionary Patriots*

This fifth of a series of profiles of monuments and plaques sponsored by the Sergeant Lawrence Everhart Chapter Sons of the American Revolution in Frederick County features a memorial to Abraham Lakin II. The roadside historic marker is on Fry Road in Jefferson, Maryland, a mile and a half north of Route 464. The marker was dedicated May 6, 1979.

The inscription on the roadside marker reads:

Abraham Lakin 2nd
Born Oct. 16, 1713 or 1722. Died Jan., 1796
Veteran of French and Indian War,
Early Settler, Head of Family of
Revolutionary Patriots Buried In
Cemetery of Homestead Near Here. At
Outset of The Revolution He and His
Sons Abraham, Basil, Daniel, John, and
His Nephew Samuel Were Listed With
Committee of Observation of Middle
District of Frederick County. Basil and
Another Son, William, Were Soldiers.
Two Of His Daughters, Nancy and Sarah,
Married Revolutionary Soldiers.
